ROUTE 80 WEST FROM POINTS EAST (NORTH & CENTRAL BERGEN COUNTY, GEORGE WASHINGTON BRIDGE, CONNECTIONS TO NJ TURNPIKE & GARDEN STATE PARKWAY)

- Route 80 West
- Exit 53 (Route 23, Wayne, Butler, Verona)
- Follow signs for Route 23 North towards Butler
- Take exit for Route 202 South, Alt 511, Boonton, Lincoln Park (landmark Wayne Dodge is at the exit)
- Turn left onto Mountainview Blvd (202) at the end of the ramp
- At the traffic light, turn right on Parish Drive
- Bear right onto PAL Drive just before the bridge
- Follow PAL Drive to the PAL complex

ROUTE 80 EAST FROM POINTS WEST (MORRIS & WARREN COUNTIES, DELAWARE WATER GAP, CONNECTIONS TO ROUTE 287)

- There is no exit for route 23 North from Route 80 East
- Make a U-Turn at exit 54 (Minisink Road)
- Turn left at the end of the ramp
- Cross over Route 80
- Turn Left on Vreeland Avenue
- Turn Left on to the ramp for Route 80 West
- Follow the directions "Route 80 West from points east (North & Central Bergen County, George Washington Bridge, connections to NJ Turnpike & Garden State Parkway)"

ROUTE 23 SOUTH FROM POINTS NORTH (NORTHERN PASSAIC & SUSSEX COUNTIES, PORT JERVIS NY AREA, CONNECTIONS TO ROUTE 287)

- Route 23 South
- Take exit for Route 202 South, Alt 511, Boonton, Lincoln Park
- Continue straight onto Sherman Street at the end of the ramp
- Turn right onto Mountainview Blvd
- At the traffic light, turn Left on Parish Drive
- Bear right onto PAL Drive just before the bridge
- Follow PAL Drive to the PAL complex

ROUTE 23 NORTH FROM POINTS SOUTH (ESSEX COUNTY, CONNECTIONS TO ROUTE 46 BY WILLOWBROOK MALL)

- Route 23 North (watch the signs around the junction of Routes 46 and 80)
- Take exit for Route 202 South, Alt 511, Boonton, Lincoln
 Park (landmark Wayne Dodge is at the exit)
- Turn left onto Mountainview Blvd (202) at the end of the ramp
- At the traffic light, turn right on Parish Drive
- Bear right onto PAL Drive just before the bridge
- Follow PAL Drive to the PAL complex
